The Los Angeles Police Department's West Traffic Division is investigating a Hit and Run pedestrian accident that occurred on December 22, 2007 at 11:30 P.M. The collision occurred on Hollywood Boulevard east of Serrano Avenue. The described vehicle hit the victim who was walking southbound Hollywood Boulevard, causing the victim to sustain serious injuries.
